

What are upgrades?

"At the heart of IATI is a data standard. This is a set of rules and guidance produced by IATI for publishing useful development and humanitarian data."



Edit - clarify guidance, make descriptions clearer



Add - new features; elements, attributes, codelists



Deprecate - parts that are unused or no longer relevant

Minor:

Minor (previously decimal) upgrades can cover changes that are optional and backwardly compatible.

Major:

Major (previously integer) upgrades can cover non-backwardly compatible changes.

Minor Upgrade Proposals

Exchange rate options: Allow publishers to give a specific exchange rate between two currencies

Publishing application: Allow publishers to give their publishing app within their file

Adding links to related OCDS contracts: Link contracts to IATI activities or transactions.

Results - recognising partner contributions: Attribute specific results to an organisation

Outgoing Commitment - conflicting description & use: Need to agree wording & use

Major Upgrade Proposals

Add a new transaction type: How to report fundraising or internal funding sources

Add an indicator schema: Gives further information about indicators used in an activity

Deprecate: Legacy data & organisation type 'Accountable'

Make mandatory: iati-activities, iati-organisations, @generated-datetime & @value-date

Make guidance into rules: Agreement that various shoulds to be turned to musts at 3.0.0

Fix contradictions: E.g. sectors from the same vocabulary Must/Should add up to 100%

*Agreed as bug fix- Activity status mixup: Change descriptions of codes 3 & 4
